We are seeking Expressions of Interest for a **Performance Psychologist** to join our team in a paid capacity. The role requires performance psychology support for Athletes and Coaches. The primary responsibilities include:

- Lead the performance psychology curriculum that adopts all aspects of the psychological development for athletes and coaches within a high-performance program.
- Collaborate with AIS and NIN Performance Psychology Leads to build capability within the program.
- Deliver individual and group performance psychology, both face to face and remote, to support a high-performance culture and the capacity for success at the highest levels of competition.
- Drive a collaborative approach across an interdisciplinary performance support team to planning, preparation and performance that optimises internal and external expertise.
- Develop resources and provide recommendations to the Wheelchair Rugby high-performance program to enhance the daily and benchmark event performance environments.

Experience

Successful applicants will have:

- 5+ years experience delivering psychology services.
- Experience working in multiple high-performance environments.
- Proven success in utilizing sport psychology knowledge for planning and managing athletes across multiple seasons/campaigns to support medal-winning performances (or equivalent).
- Demonstrated ability and commitment to work in a multi-disciplinary/sport team environment with high performance coaches and athletes.

- Current and appropriate professional indemnity insurance for the scope of services to be provided.
- Current registration or membership of a relevant National registration or membership body.
